



CMBDA Scholars Program – Year 2010/2011

Program – The Colorado Municipal Bond Dealers Association (CMBDA) is currently offering a scholarship program designed to reward high school graduates with \$1,000 scholarships to an accredited Colorado college or university. Up to Twelve (12) scholarships will be awarded. **Recipients will not be eligible to renew the scholarship.**

Eligibility – Applicants must be full-time Colorado residents, United States citizens, and enroll as a full-time student. Applicants must have a minimum 3.25 GPA on a 4.0 scale for all high school work and be considering a major in Business, Economics, Political Science, or Public Administration. Employees of CMBDA member firms and their immediate family members are not eligible.

Basis of Award – The selection of scholarship recipients will be based on scholarship, work experience, community and school activities, personal statement and, if necessary, an interview by the CMBDA Scholarship Committee.

Deadlines – **The deadline to receive your application is Friday May 21, 2010.** Recipients of the awards will be notified by mail on or before Friday June 4, 2010. Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the college once proof of enrollment has been received.

Additional Requirement – Applicants must agree to their name being used in one or more newspapers or periodicals announcing that they have received the scholarship.
